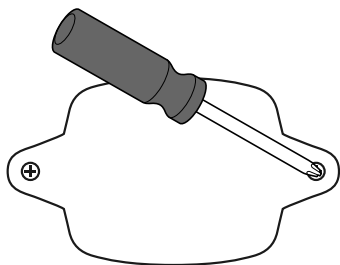
Tool required: Phillips screwdriver (not included)

## Battery Replacement



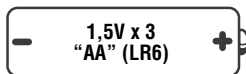
**For best performance, we recommend replacing the batteries that came with this toy with three, new “AA” (LR6) alkaline batteries.**

- Loosen the screws in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver and remove the door.
- Remove the exhausted batteries and dispose of them properly.
- Insert three, new “AA” (LR6) **alkaline** batteries.
- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screws. Do not over-tighten.
- If this toy begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power/mode switch off and back on.
- When sounds or lights become faint or stop, it’s time for an adult to change the batteries.



- Protect the environment by not disposing of this product with household waste (2002/96/EC). Check your local authority for recycling advice and facilities.

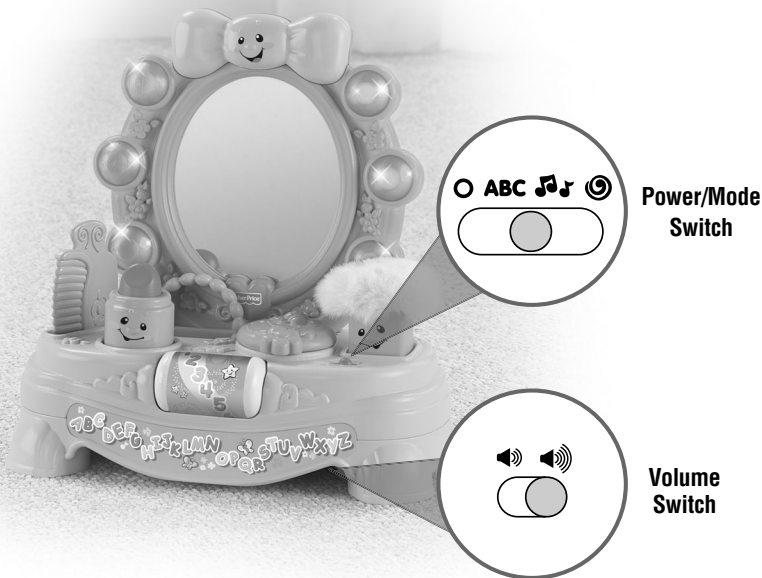
## Battery Safety Information



In exceptional circumstances, batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types: alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium).
- Insert batteries as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use. Always remove exhausted batteries from the product. Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of this product in a fire. The batteries inside may explode or leak.
- Never short-circuit the battery terminals.
- Use only batteries of the same or equivalent type, as recommended.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the product before charging.
- If removable, rechargeable batteries are used, they are only to be charged under adult supervision.

# Cheerful Music & Dancing Lights!



- Slide the power/mode switch to **ABC Learning**, **Music**, **Imagination** or **OFF**.
- Slide the volume switch to **low** or **high volume**.

## **ABC Learning Mode**

Spin the roller to hear a song. Open and close the compact to learn about opposites or hear a song. Learn about colours, textures and phrases when you pick up or replace the comb, lipstick or powder puff.

## **Music Mode**

Spin the roller to hear a song. Open the compact to hear a song about getting ready. Close the compact to stop the song. Pick up or replace the comb, lipstick or powder puff to hear a tune.

## **Imagination Mode**

Spin the roller to hear fun tunes. Open and close the compact to hear phrases and sound effects. Hear even more fun phrases when you pick up or replace the comb, lipstick or powder puff!
