




Before Use

Assembly




• Fit the ends of the handle onto the tabs on each side of the mower base.



- Fit a cap onto each side of the handle.
- Insert a screw into each cap and tighten the screw with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.

Battery Replacement




For best performance, we recommend replacing the batteries that came with this toy with three, new "AA" (LR6) alkaline batteries.

- Loosen the screw in the battery compartment door with a Phillips screwdriver. Remove the battery compartment door.
- Insert three, new "AA" (LR6)
 alkaline batteries

Hint: We recommend using **alkaline** batteries for longer battery life.

- Replace the battery compartment door and tighten the screw with a Phillips screwdriver. Do not over-tighten.
- If this product begins to operate erratically, you may need to reset the electronics. Slide the power/mode switch off and then back on.
- When sounds or lights from this toy become faint or stop, it's time for an adult to change the batteries!
